

Bring Your Own Learning Tool (BYOLT) Requirements Checklist



The following specifications outline **Bring Your Own Learning Tool** (BYOLT) models, permitted to connect to the CEDP ICT network. In addition:

- 1. all BYOLT authorised to connect to the CEDP ICT network are required to be enrolled;
- 2. **enrolled** Bring Your Own Learning Tools automatically receive the necessary settings to connect to the CEDP ICT network:
- 3. **non-enrolled** Bring Your Own Learning Tools will not be able to access the Internet via the CEDP ICT network;
- 4. for the purpose of network security/management and student safety, **user identification**, **device specifications** and **application data** is captured via the enrolment process; and
- 5. CEDP reserves the right to temporarily or permanently **restrict or prevent** any Bring Your Own Learning Tool connecting to the CEDP ICT network.



Devices & Operating Systems

- Apple iPad IOS 10.0 or above
- Apple Laptop OS 10.9 or above
- Chromebooks latest Chrome OS, manufactured after 2013
- Windows Tablet / Laptop Windows 7 or 10



Wireless Connectivity

- Devices must support the 3 following:
- wireless frequencies (2.4 GHz & 5 GHz)
- 802.11 "a", "g", "n" and/or "ac" wireless standards
- WPA2 enterprise security



Screen Size

 Ensure the screen size is of a reasonable size not less than 9 inches (23cm, measured diagonally) and a resolution of 600 dpi to enable ease of use throughout the school day.



Hardware Features

- A camera/video camera and microphone is necessary to ensure students can participate in 21st century learning activities
- A stylus or keyboard is optional though may be useful



Battery Life

6hrs minimum battery life. The device needs to last a full school day.



Memory and RAM

- To be able to store and process data effectively the device requires:
- iPads/Tablets 32GB storage (and 1GB RAM for non-iPad tablets)
- Chromebooks 16GB storage and 1GB RAM
- Laptops 128GB storage and 4GB RAM



Other Considerations

- A tough, sturdy cover/case in the event the device is dropped
- Light enough for your child to carry each day
- **Durability** of the device
- Insurance in the event the device is broken or lost
- Extra warranty to reduce future possible repair costs
